PURPOSE: Perform general maintenance and preventative/predictive maintenance on a variety of Printing / Bagging / Extrusion, auxiliary and plant support equipment. Individual is required to have proven knowledge and skill of mechanical, electrical, pneumatic, hydraulic theory and procedure to troubleshoot, perform preventative maintenance and complete necessary repairs. The overall goal is to assist in minimizing downtime due to breakdown repairs and PM's and to optimize the quality of products manufactured to the highest degree equipment is capable of producing. This role will encompass the following tasks specifically but can be called upon to assist in technical matters as deemed necessary by the Maintenance Manager.

JOB DUTIES:

- Follows all established safety rules and guidelines as outlined in the Employee Handbook and as trained during the various safety-related training programs. Understands and communicates all hazards and safety issues to co-workers, leads, and managers.
- Properly uses all personal protective equipment and follows all LOTO procedures.
- Knowledge and ability to repair production equipment, based on the following technical skills:
- Must be capable of performing maintenance on all types of equipment represented in the plant with a high degree of skill and competency.
- Ability to competently troubleshoot electrical circuits.
- Ability to read electrical, hydraulic and pneumatic schematics and identify symbols and control circuits with a high degree of competency. Includes the ability to understand and troubleshoot PLC I/O.
- Applies knowledge of machines and processes for each of the following to analyze, setup and maintain equipment for safe and continuous operation.
- Must be capable of re-working and modifying electrical, hydraulic and pneumatic equipment to repair, change or upgrade the status of equipment (i.e. installation of 3 Phase motors, Servo motors, VFD's, install relays and starters, install control circuits, pumps, compressors, and others).
- Perform preventative and corrective maintenance on all production equipment
- Provide support and guidance to associates when necessary to help advance their performance.
- Follow up with work center personnel to make sure that quality repairs are being performed on the production equipment.
- Assist production in the training and development of the operators in the required specific areas.

PURPOSE: Set up and operate flexographic printing press in printing of flexible packaging.

JOB DUTIES:

- Read and understand work orders and bring proper materials to press
- Perform press change-overs by changing inks, gears, sleeves, bridges, clean plates and sleeves
- Load and unload rolls from both rewind and unwind by job tag and inventory tag. When loading rolls to unwind be able to interpret the treated side and bag opening side to determine correct loading direction. Create flying splice as necessary.
- Read and interpret rewind chart.
- Can enter production into DCU, prints labels for rolls and pallets
- Can ensure safe operation and quality of press unsupervised while pressman is away from the press
- Operate InkSpec automatic viscosity controller.
- Set up new jobs and enter information into press CPU.
- Check new jobs for correct copy and specifications. Set up jobs in proper sequence to allow high-speed production.
- Adjust impression settings, registration, tension controls, and web guides.
- Unload printed rolls from rewind and palletize or take to the next operation. Inspect tear sheets for quality control with regard to print, color, registration, repeat tolerance, ink adhesion.
- Maintain press equipment by working with maintenance and have the ability to do minor maintenance.
- Enter production tracking and downtime information into the DCU. Make and print finished goods labels for inventory.
- Train assistant in assistant's responsibilities.
